The design of the Pulsifer Hampton is based on the Casco Bay Hampton, a lobster boat built by Charlie Gomes from 1902 through the 1950s. Charlie Gomes' Hamptons were work boats. Designed first and foremost for function – to be used, to work hard, and to endure – the same qualities I have vested in the Pulsifer Hamptons I build today.
